- What do you want to say to them to help cheer them up and help them feel your love?
- Do you need to apologize to anyone before you die?
- Who has unfinished business with you and probably needs closure with you?
- Do you want or need to forgive anyone?
- Who made a big impression on your life?
- When were some of the highlights of your life? Who was there? What made it special?
- What are some of your favorite songs (and why?) that others can listen to and connect with you?
- Favorite scripture (and why?)
- Favorite movies (and why?)
- Favorite places and/or vacations
- Favorite books, poems, and/or sayings
- What are some of your personal belongings that mean a lot to you?
- What do you want your children and grandchildren to know about you?
- How have people made your life better?
- How did you show others that you loved them?
- What do you wish you did differently in your life if you had a re-do?
- How do you want to be remembered?
- How do you want to reassure others that you are at peace with your death?
- What are you grateful for in your life?
- Do you have any places or things to do on your bucket list?
- Where are places you never visited that others can go in your honor?

- What charities mean the most to you?
- What are some of your life lessons that you're grateful you learned?
- What would you tell the younger generation—if they'd listen?
- What helped you get through some of your hard times? What didn't help?
- What are your priorities that you would like taken care of and how can I help?
